- Volunteers share small cards with women in their community



# "Pass it on" Project

- Share Cards at
  - Churches
  - Community groups
  - Local events
  - Neighborhoods
  - Grocery stores
  - Family events
- Benefits of Project
  - Help women with no other resources get free mammograms and Pap tests
  - Help save lives of women in your community through early detection



# "Pass it on" Project

- How much time is required?
  - A few minutes each time you see women who might be eligible
  - Give a card to individual women
  - Request more cards when needed
